### HANDLING CRITERIA

# General behaviour standards:

- Pressurized container. Protect from sunlight and do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50 ° C.
- Do not pierce or burn after use.
- Do not spray on naked flame or incandescent material.
- Use and store away from sources of ignition and electrical equipment.
- Not smoking.
- Carefully follow the instructions on the package or leaflet / tie / tag attached.
- Avoid any kind of use not foreseen in the instructions.
- Avoid spraying in the eyes or on irritated skin and inhaling intentionally.
- Spray for short periods of time and provide sufficient ventilation after use.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Throw just empty bottles into the trash bin.

### ACCIDENTAL WASTE PREVENTION MEASURES

Eliminate any naked flame from the areas concerned; stop leakage, ventilate the area if you can not present danger. Collect spillage with a cloth and wash with plenty of water. In the event of a massive spill alert the Fire Brigade.

Personal protection: Use gloves, goggles, gas mask, etc.

### FIRE PREVENTION MEASURES

**Flammability:** Extremely flammable; possible risk of explosion in case of fire. Type of fire extinguishers: Use dry or CO2 extinguishers for small fires and water spray or foam for large fires. Cool containers with water.

Special Protective Equipment: Use gloves, goggles, gas mask

## **DISPOSAL INFORMATION**

# STORAGE CRITERIA

# Optimum storage conditions:

Keep the containers in upright position and secure, avoiding the possibility of falls and / or shocks. Store in a dry and well ventilated rooms at temperatures not lower than 5 ° C and not higher than 35 ° C, in non-smoking rooms and away from flames, heat sources and electrical equipment.
